Interviews

Mayor Heroux and Attleboro Personnel Director Owen Bebeau led interviews of the two finalists for the APL Director position. The candidates were interviewed separately and each presented a "5 year plan" for APL. Each candidate had approximately 45 minutes to present and to answer questions from the Mayor, Mr. Bebeau, and the Trustees. After the interviews, the Mayor led a discussion reviewing the candidates presentations and qualifications. All agreed that both candidates gave effective presentations and each demonstrated a strong commitment to public libraries and serving patrons. (The candidates were not present for the post-interview discussion.) At the conclusion of the discussion, the Trustees voted to recommend one of the finalists for the Mayor's consideration. Mayor Heroux will make a final decision and Mr. Bebeau will check references and finalize the hiring process.
