



# Dragon Eggs



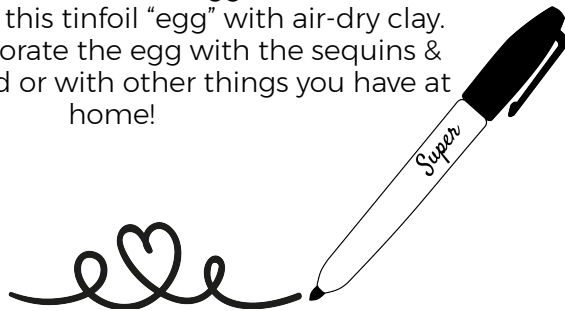
**Materials Provided:**

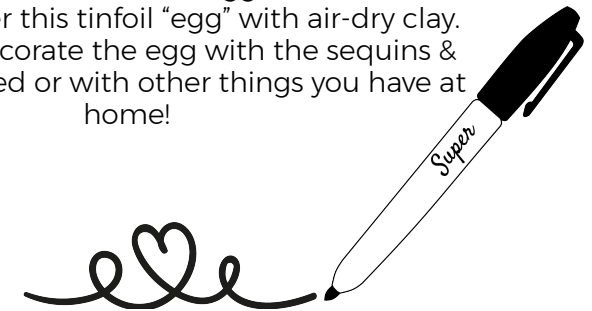
