2. Read/listen to TWO books and log them on your ReadSquared account. That's it! You'll automatically be entered into our prize drawing. Winners will be drawn on Friday, August 14th and contacted by a librarian.

### Option 2: On paper

1. Read/Listen to TWO books and complete the attached "Rate this Book!" form
2. Return the form to the Library by placing it in the bookdrop or dropping it off at our main desk (if we are open). That's it! You'll automatically be entered into our prize drawing. Winners will be drawn on Friday, August 14th and contacted by a librarian.
