How to download & stream free videos, music, audiobooks, comics, and ebooks on your mobile device or computer.

- 1. Register for a hoopla account by visiting **hoopladigital.com**, or by using our mobile app on your iOS or Android device. You will need to provide an e-mail address, create a password, and have your library account information ready. Our free mobile app can be found in the App Store and the Google Play store.
- 2. Easily browse titles on your computer or mobile device by clicking **Browse All** on the format (Music, Movies, Audiobooks, eBooks, Comics, and Television) you would like to browse further on. You can also search for a specific title by clicking on the **Search** box or magnifying glass and typing in your title(s)/keyword.
- 3. To borrow a title, click on the title and then click the **Borrow** button. Your borrowed titles can be played right after borrowing, and found under the **My Titles** menu for viewing/listening. Enjoy your selected titles!
- 4. Borrowed titles will be automatically returned when your lending period is over. There are no holds, wait lists, or late fees for any of hoopla's content.
- 5. If you need additional help, visit the help section on our mobile app, or click on the Help link found at the bottom of **hoopladigital.com**.

How many items can I borrow?

The Attleboro Public Library currently allows users to borrow 8 hoopla items per month. (Subject to change)

How long will I have my items for?

Most Movies and TV episodes are available for 72 hours (3 days) from the time you borrow the title. Some publishers limit the borrow time to 48 hours (2 days). Most Music albums are available for 7 days from the time you borrow the title. Most Audiobooks, Comics, and eBooks are available for 21 days from the time you borrow the title.

Will I need to wait in line for popular items?

No! Hoopla items are available for streaming/downloading on-demand, which means that multiple patrons can access the same items at once. There are no holds or waitlists.

How do I borrow hoopla items?

There are multiple ways to borrow hoopla items:

Hoopla app/website: Hoopla items can be downloaded directly from hoopladigital.com or through the free hoopla app. Instructions can be found on the opposite side of this flyer.

-OR-

SAILS catalog: To download hoopla items from the SAILS catalog, follow the instructions below.

- Items in the SAILS catalog with a digital format of HOOPLA can be accessed from the catalog.
- 2. Simply click the *Download* button.
- 3. Enter your library card number and PIN.
- 4. You will automatically be redirected to the hoopla website. Click the *Borrow* button below the item.
- 5. Enter you hoopla login credentials (you will need to create an account if you don't already have one). That's it! Your item is now available for streaming in your web browser, and simultaneously added to your account on the hoopla app (if you choose to use the app).
