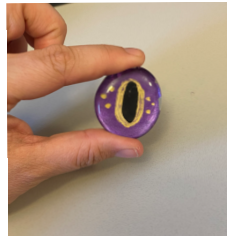




# Dragon Eyes



## Materials Provided:

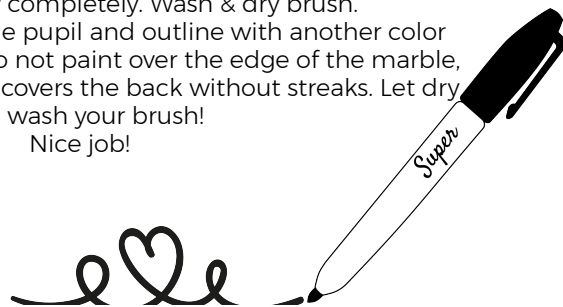
- Acrylic Paint- Black, Gold & two additional colors
- 2 Glass Marbles
- Paint brush

**Step One-** Using the black paint, make a thin pupil. Leave space on the top and bottom, do not paint all the way to the edge. Let dry completely. Wash brush and let it dry. (Or use different brush for next step)

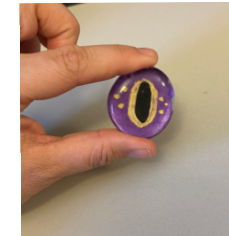
**Step Two-** Using the gold paint and brush, trace the outside of the pupil with a thin line. Add some gold dots on either side if you'd like. Let dry completely. Wash & dry brush.

**Step Three-** Paint over the pupil and outline with another color (green, red, purple etc.) Do not paint over the edge of the marble, make this layer thick so it covers the back without streaks. Let dry and wash your brush!
