# Make Your Own Tote Bag!

**Step One-** Use Paper to line the inside of the bag. (Recycled newspaper etc. It will get paint on it so don't use anything you need.) Make sure you are wearing a smock or clothing that you could get paint on, acrylic does not come off. Protect your table as well.

**Step Two-** Place the design on the bag where you would like it. You can use the stencil provided or make your own! You may want to tape the underside of the design to the bag so it doesn't move.

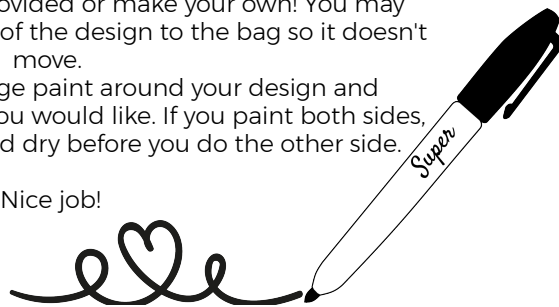
**Step Three-** Paint! Sponge paint around your design and anywhere else on the bag you would like. If you paint both sides, make sure one is done and dry before you do the other side.

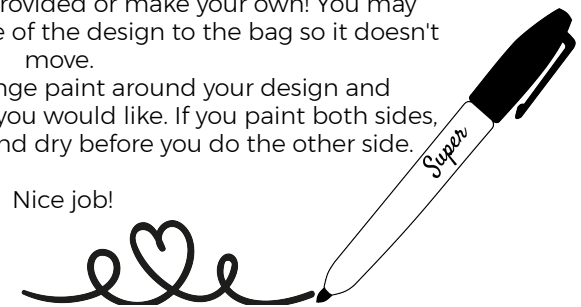
**Step Two-** Place the design on the bag where you would like it. You can use the stencil provided or make your own! You may want to tape the underside of the design to the bag so it doesn't move.
