

Getting started with **libby** the new, free app from OverDrive

The Libby app is a new, one-tap reading app for borrowing digital books and audiobooks from your library

1

Install the Libby app from your device's app store.

2

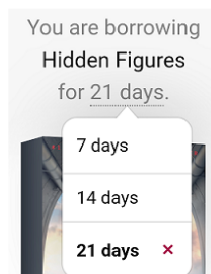
Open the app and find your library. You can search by library name, city, or zip code.

3

When prompted, sign in. Select "SAILS Library Patrons" from the drop down menu on the left. Enter your library barcode number. The pin should be the last four digits of your phone number.

4

Browse your library's collection and borrow a title. Be sure to select "21 days" as the lending period. Titles can always be returned early.



Borrowed titles appear on your **Shelf** and download to the app automatically so you can read them when you're offline.

From your **Shelf**, you can:

- Tap **Start Reading** or **Start Listening** to open a title.
- Tap the cover image, then **Send to Device** to send a book to your Kindle.
- You will be redirected to Amazon- don't worry, it's still free! Select "Get library book" and login to your Amazon account if prompted. Make sure your Kindle is connected to wifi and your ebook will download instantly!
