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## Minutes

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## Director's Report

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Written report submitted and reviewed. In conjunction with the Tour of Downtown Attleboro walking tour on June 1<sup>st</sup>, Chris asked the Board for permission to let APL provide for public purchase Attleboro Historic Preservation Society Walking Tour Guides. The guides can be purchased for \$10 each and all proceeds will go to the Attleboro Historic Preservation Society. Chris also requested \$735 for an upcoming annual ALA conference in Washington DC. Motions made and approved in accordance with each request.

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## New Business

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On Monday, March 11, Chris and four trustees met with Mayor Heroux to tour the Highland Country Club (HCC) in regard to the mayor's idea that APL consider relocating because of the expense involved with needed repairs to the existing APL building. Handicap accessibility is an issue as the building has two floors and there is no elevator. The Board is awaiting the results of the Library Needs Assessment Study before any further action/discussion on the issue.

Vic expressed concern about the possibility of APL being relocated but this issue was tabled until the Needs Assessment was complete.

Vic also informed the Board that the portraits on the second floor have been labeled with placards identifying each subject and his/her relation to APL.

Vic suggested that the Board should consider being more active in regard to increasing the trust funds through the work of the Friends. Discussion ensued about how this can best be accomplished. Charlie is going to get some more info and possibly invite a guest speaker to talk about the kinds of charitable donations and how to inform the public about various giving opportunities.

Vic revisited the issue of APL staff wearing name tags. Chris is going to ask APL staff to identify themselves to patrons by wearing a name tag designating them by first name or "staff member".
