Tissue Paper Stained Glass Hummingbird

Supplies Provided: Hummingbird cut out wax paper tissue paper

Supplies Needed from Home: Glue stick Scissors



- -- Cut the wax paper in the general shape of the hummingbird design. To do this, place your hummingbird cut out on the wax paper and cut around it. Make the wax paper a little bigger than your hummingbird cut out.
- -- Cut (or rip) the colored tissue paper into small pieces and glue them on the wax paper in a design.
- -- Once the wax paper is completely covered and glue dry, glue the hummingbird cut out on the side of the parchment paper where there is no tissue paper. (you will be able to see the colors through that side.) Then cut the extra parchment paper from around the edges, so that the hummingbird cut out is your border.
