## Attleboro's Kindness Community Read

Attleboro Commission on Disabilities READS! (Mon., Dec. 9, 6:30-7:30pm): Join Mary Flaherty from the Attleboro Commission on Disabilities for a read-aloud of the picture book *I Am Quiet*, then enjoy a fun activity! This program is part of Attleboro's Reading Passport program for kids in grades K-4, so bring your passport to be stamped.
