

Supplies Jncluded Construction paper Paper Bag Supplies From Home Scissors Glue Stick Markers Pencil Tape

1. Fold a piece of construction paper on half long-wise, slightly off center.

- 2. Make snips all along the fold, each about 1/4" wide. Do not snip through
- the paper but leave about an inch on the bottom of the paper uncut.
- 3. Invert the cut paper along the fold and secure it in place using the glue stick.
- 4. Then roll it up. Use a pencil to start the rolling process.
- 5. Once it is rolled up, secure it with a couple pieces of scotch tape.
- 6. Make a "pot" for your flowers by drawing a design on the front bottom half of a paper lunch bag.
- 7. Then open it up and fold down the top of the paper bag about 3 times.8. Place the paper flowers that you have made into your pot. About 3 flowers fills it nicely.
