



Bug Buddies



Supplies Provided

Cardboard tube
Colorful paper
Cardstock scraps
Pipe cleaner
Wiggle eyes

Supplies From Home

Glue or Tape
Markers
Scissors

1. Cover the cardboard tube. Cut a piece of colorful paper into a rectangle that is 4" wide and about 6" long. Wrap the paper around the paper tube and glue or tape to secure it in place.

2. Make the bug details. Create some wings, antenna etc (OPTIONAL--trace the templates) onto cardstock. Mix and match the wings, heads, and antennae to make a customized bug! Decorate your wings in any way you wish.

3. Assemble the bugs. Glue the wings to the paper roll. Glue on the wiggle eyes and use a black marker to draw a small mouth.

4. Make the pipe cleaner legs and antennae. To make antennae, take a piece of pipe cleaner and fold it into a V shape. Apply a small dab of glue to the point of the V and attach it to the back of the bug's head.

Cut 6 pieces of pipe cleaner and bend them into leg shapes. You can bend and curve the legs into symmetrical shapes or keep the pipe cleaners straight. Glue each pipe cleaner leg to the back of the paper roll.
