



Patriotic Pinwheel



Supplies Provided:

Stickers
Metal Brad
Pony Bead
Straw

Supplies From Home:

Supplies to Color With (NOT paint, it will be too heavy and the pinwheel may not spin)
Hole Punch
Scissors
Glue

1. Color and decorate their pinwheel
2. Cut out the pinwheel. Follow along the outside of the square, and then cut on the four diagonal lines. Make sure to not don't cut all the way to the middle
3. Use the hole punch to punch one hole in each of the circles
4. To assemble the pinwheel start with one corner, bend it towards the center making sure NOT to fold or crease it. Hold the metal brad above the center of the pinwheel with the flat part at the top and the metal tabs facing down (like a mushroom). Put the brad through the hole and continue to the next corner until all four corners are secured
5. Bend the ends of the brad to keep the pinwheel in place
6. Put the pony bead on the brad
7. Glue the pony bead to the straw. **MAKE SURE NOT TO GLUE THE PINWHEEL OR IT WON'T SPIN.**
